Meeting called to order at 7:09 p.m. by Supervisor Mark Englerth.

PURPOSE OF MEETING:

PURPOSE OF MEETING

Board will work on GLASWA's Articles of Incorporation as per Special Meeting of September 27th, 2018.

Clerk Lippert read YS Twp. minutes of 11/13/17 regarding motion to have L. Knowles fill vacancy of R. Rottschafer. (Pg. 2 of 3 attached). Discussion occurred at the Nov. 13th meeting that referred to an email to L. Knowles from Attorney Rob Thall, dated 11/13/17. (Attached). This email was distributed at the meeting.

Clerk Lippert noted that after going out for PC interviews, M. Boysen was then appointed.

Also: Clerk Lippert distributed (to board members) an email from Catherine Kaufman, which was Confidential/Attorney Client Privileged dated 7/13/18. This was not read to those in attendance.

Also distributed: An adopted amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of GLASWA, adopted by all four townships dated 1/3/17 by Orangeville Twp., 1/9/17 by Wayland Twp., 1/11/17 by Martin Township and 2/9/17 by Yankee Springs Township.

A copy of the full GLASWA Articles of Incorporation was distributed to Board members as well.

Lippert also distributed the GLASWA Minutes of Sept. 6, 2018. “There is no mention of G. Leep contacting a second opinion from an attorney regarding the Articles of Incorporation,” commented Clerk Lippert.

Lippert commented that she understood that the attorney that was contacted was Roger Swets, (of Dickinson Wright), which is not C. Kaufman’s firm.

Boysen inquired if GLASWA would be paying for another opinion. L. Knowles confirmed that GLASWA was going to be paying for it and that GLASWA Board’s G. Leep is trying to contact an attorney for a second opinion. Knowles noted this attorney is not to have any other business with any of the four (4) townships. Knowles commented that R. Swets was contacted by G. Leep and Swets was to contact Yankee Springs Twp. to see if it approved (to give a second opinion).

Englerth asked L. Knowles if the GLASWA board knew about Rob Thall’s opinion. Knowles commented that he thinks the Board would have knowledge of it. Knowles commented that he thought that Englerth might have been the one (on the GLASWA Board) that asked for a third party opinion.

Englerth inquired again regarding the GLASWA board’s knowledge of R. Thall’s opinion (emailed in November 2017). Knowles commented that he (Knowles) asked R. Thall for the opinion and that he (Knowles) paid for it, and L. Knowles said he asked for the opinion, and doesn’t remember if the GLASWA board was informed or not. L. Knowles noted the opinion (R. Thall’s) did go to YS Township.

Englerth commented that the Board of Trustees was all in agreeance “that the Letter of Incorporation has to be amended in order for him (L. Knowles) to continue to be Administrator of the Sewer Authority.”

A. Jansma, Treasurer, inquired about the election results (L. Knowles was elected as the new Trustee for a two year term).

Englerth commented “We don’t affect elections. If he (L. Knowles) wins an election he sits on the township board. The question is, ‘Can he continue to be employed by the Sewer Authority?’ And we’ve got two attorneys from the same law firm agreeing that the only way he (L. Knowles) can do that is you can amend the Letter of Incorporation. But that is not enough. It needs to be done by all four (4) townships and then we have to ask, ‘Do we want to amend that Letter of Incorporation? Does it make sense? Is it right? Historically, what has been done?’”

Jansma asked, “Don’t we, all four townships, have to vote on the same language? Englerth answered, “If we amend it, yes. Right now we are deciding whether we are even interested in amending it, or should we (amend the Articles of Incorporation)? That’s what we are doing tonight.”

Clerk Lippert commented, “For the record, we did the first amendment, Feb. 9, 2017- “that amendment at GLASWA said (Lippert referred to when other board members could be made township representatives on the GLASWA Board besides township supervisors) ...so we changed it....” Clerk Lippert commented that now the township could do a second amendment.

Englerth distributed a letter dated 4/4/16 regarding an Airport Manager of Hastings, and the same person being a County Commissioner. Englerth commented that the individual could not be in both positions (at the same time).

Englerth commented that Pat Jansens was not able to hold a board position and do work for the township (such as in a \$12.00/\$14.00 per hour job).

Englerth commented that in order for L. Knowles to be a Trustee, for Yankee Springs, he (Knowles) must resign as Director from GLASWA, unless the Articles of Incorporation of GLASWA is amended.

Trustee Vandenberg commented that he’d like to reference that Mr. Hines had to resign from being Supervisor of Wayland to work at GLASWA. Vandenberg wonders why the Board is going to change the way it is operating and why it is changing it.

Vandenberg commented that if he (S. Vandenberg), Englerth and Knowles are at the GLASWA meetings, “Wouldn’t there be a little bit of a problem if three members go to a meeting? Isn’t that a problem?”

Englerth commented that a Special Meeting could be held.

S. Vandenberg continued, “So what if I went to every other meeting? So every other meeting we’d have to call a special meeting? What if all the other townships do the same thing?” Discussion took place.

Lippert read the public notice posted at the sign in table of the YS Township Hall enacted June 20, 2013: “...there may be a quorum of the YS Twp. Board of Trustees present in the audience,. (see attached).

M. Boysen commented “Should we” is the key words that he heard Englerth say. Boysen asked “Is it ethically right to sit on both boards (Director of GLASWA and YS Twp. Board of Trustees)?. Boysen commented from a layperson’s position that it didn’t seem right. Boysen commented that if you paid a certain amount of money to an attorney they will give you the answer you seek. Boysen commented if getting another opinion “is even ethical...” Boysen felt there was enough collusion going on, and that ethically it doesn’t seem right.

Englerth commented it was never an issue or needed for forty years until this situation came up. “To amend the Articles of Incorporation, for the sake of one individual, I believe, is not correct. I think the path that puts you down... Let’s say Tom Rook., he retires in a year, (then) he’s the assistant manager (at GLASWA). It just doesn’t pass the taste test.”

Englerth spoke with L. Knowles requesting GLASWA to replace the line to be done with PEX. Knowles was agreeable with the replacement. Knowles commented that he had no idea what occurred prior to 2015, and 2013 was when the last line was replaced or repaired. Knowles noted he will have a contractor do the work. Englerth requested a call on the day the contractor is there (at 12860 Goldenrod) to do the work. L. Knowles agreed to call Englerth.

Englerth made available documentation that Englerth referred to this evening regarding serving two governmental roles (at once) to Deb Mousseau, Recording Secretary. All of Englerth's documentation was copied and distributed to the other board members' mailboxes after tonight's meeting.

Englerth added that he had let the limit be extended in the past, but wouldn't be doing that this evening. Englerth commented on going in a new, positive direction. <p> <u>PURPOSE OF MEETING:</u> <u>Replacement of Trustee- Due to Resignation of Trustee Rottschafer</u> (effective immediately) and <u>Replacement of Zoning Administrator – Due to Resignation of Larry Knowles</u> (effective immediately). Englerth commented on <u>The Rules of Engagement</u>. Englerth commented "In a perfect world we don't need a set of rules. We should all express our feelings and our concerns and move forward in a positive direction. Somehow we kind of need to get back on that track." Englerth requested a copy of the Resolution (from the MTA). J. Lippert stated the Resolution from MTA was in the Board packet at Wednesday's meeting. Motion by A. Jansma with support from Lippert to appoint L. Knowles as Trustee to YS Township Board due to vacancy created by Rottschafer's resignation. Englerth: No, Lippert: Yes, Jansma: Yes, VandenBerg: No. Yes: 2, No: 2. TIE VOTE.

Discussion prior to the vote (on motion above): It has been approved with the lawyer(s) regarding the appointment of L. Knowles to the Trustee position per A. Jansma. Jansma provided legal documentation for Englerth. (attachment E-Mail 11-13-17 Rob Thall)

Englerth favored for advertisement for candidates. "For transparency with everybody ... With the bumps and grinds that we've had, I don't think it would be perceived that we are doing our jobs. But that's just me," remarked Englerth.

M. Englerth and S. VandenBerg requested advertisement for the position. VandenBerg "It doesn't seem reasonable to me to cut everybody else out."

Motion by VandenBerg with support by Englerth to advertise for position of Trustee vacated by R. Rottschafer in local newspapers. Roll Call Vote: Englerth: yes, VandenBerg : yes, Jansma: No, Lippert: No. TIE VOTE.

In regards to a time frame -- A. Jansma reiterated the importance of the 45 day limit to have a replacement.

Discussion took place regarding when advertisement would go in the paper, time length for running ad, also evening hours and Saturday morning hours for interviews were discussed along with time of meeting.

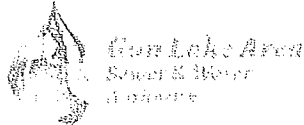

Hi Larry, below you can see the provision from the Michigan Constitution that allows what would otherwise be an incompatibility of office. Normally, a incompatibility of offices exists when there is subordination or supervision of one office to the other, or a breach of fiduciary duty (ie can't be on both sides of a contract). The below allows for Township Board members to serve on or "with" inter-local agreement Boards and Authorities. To carry this out the following would need to occur:

1. Yankee Springs Township would appoint you Trustee within 45 days of resignation.
2. Yankee Springs Township would then authorize you to perform duties as Director of the Sewer Authority.
3. The Sewer Authority would revise its Articles of Incorporation allowing for a Member's Trustee to also serve with the Authority Board as Director.

I have also reviewed this issue with Attorney Kaufman and we are in agreement with this process which must include the amendment to the Articles. Please let me know if they intend to proceed with this course of action. Thanks----Rob

§ 28 Governmental functions and powers; joint administration, costs and credits, transfers.

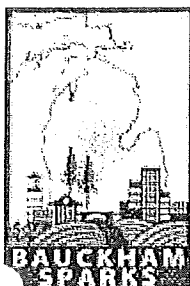
Sec. 28.

The legislature by general law shall authorize two or more counties, townships, cities, villages or districts, or any combination thereof among other things to: enter into contractual undertakings or agreements with one another or with the state or with any combination thereof for the joint administration of any of the functions or powers which each would have the power to perform separately; share the costs and responsibilities of functions and services with one another or with the state or with any combination thereof which each would have the

power to perform separately; transfer functions or responsibilities to one another or any combination thereof upon the consent of each unit involved; cooperate with one another and with state government; lend their credit to one another or any combination thereof as provided by law in connection with any authorized publicly owned undertaking.

Any other provision of this constitution notwithstanding, an officer or employee of the state or any such unit of government or subdivision or agency thereof, except members of the legislature, may serve on or with any governmental body established for the purposes set forth in this section and shall not be required to relinquish his office or employment by reason of such service.

ADOPTION OF AMENDMENT TO
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
GUN LAKE AREA SEWER AUTHORITY

Article VII of the Articles of Incorporation of the Gun Lake Area Sewer Authority (the "Authority") is hereby amended to read as follows:

Article VII

The governing body of the Authority shall be comprised of one elected official from each of the four (4) townships named in Article II. Each Commissioner shall qualify by taking the constitutional oath of office and filing it with his respective Township Clerk. Commissioners may succeed themselves. Within thirty (30) days after the effective date of the incorporation of the Authority the members of the first Commission shall qualify, by taking the constitutional oath of office and shall meet for the purpose of organization. At such organizational meeting the Commission shall select a Chairman and Vice Chairman, who shall be members of the Commission, and a Secretary and a Treasurer, or a combined Secretary-Treasurer, who need not be members of the Commission. Such officers shall serve until the organizational meeting of the following year, which shall be held annually on the first business day of February each year, or until their respective successors shall be selected and qualify. No selection of an officer of the Commission shall be deemed to be invalid because it was not made within or at the time specified in these Articles.

The Commissioners shall serve with compensation, which shall not be paid however until such time that money is available, and at that time they shall be paid the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each meeting which he may attend, not to exceed Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$2,400.00) per year, except that if any Commissioner shall serve as Secretary or Treasurer, or Secretary-Treasurer, he may receive for such services such reasonable compensation as may be fixed by the Commission. Each Commissioner shall be entitled to reimbursement for all expenditures made by him in carrying out his official duties, including a reasonable allowance for traveling expenses.

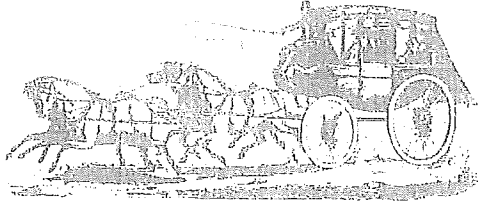

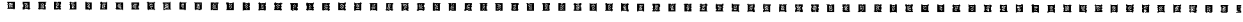
