### AGREEMENT FOR TEMPORARY EASEMENT

This agreement made this 18th day of November, 2020, by and between Frank J. McCarthy and Patricia A Senseba of 8349 Willson Road, Middleville, Michigan 49333 hereinafter referred to as "Grantor" and the Township of Yankee Springs of 284 North Briggs Road, Middleville, Michigan 49333, hereinafter referred to as "Township"

WHEREAS, the Township desired, and continues to desire, access to Turner Lake for the purpose of acquiring from time to time water for the fire department, and

WHEREAS, the Grantor owns a parcel of land bordering Turner Lake, as later described herein and

WHEREAS the Township, with the permission of the Grantor, has installed pipes and equipment on Grantor's property for that purpose and

WHEREAS the Grantor is willing to allow access for the Township across the Grantor's property for the limited putpose of installing pipes and equipment and acquiring water for the fire department from Turner Lake, upon the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Description: the property involved is described as Lot 20 of Willson's Plat of Turner Lake, according to the recorded plat thereof, Yankee Springs Township, Barry County, Michigan being a part of section 23, Town 3 North, Range 10 West,
- 2. Purpose: The easement granted herein is temporary and may be revoked by the Grantor, or their successor in interest, their successors and assigns, at any time by writing delivered to the Township by first class mail or by personally delivering the notice to the Township at their regular office notifying the Township of the termination of this easement. Such notice of termination of the easement shall be effective immediately.
