| <p> <b><u>Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Supervisor Mark Englerth.</u></b><br/> <b><u>PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:</u></b><br/> <b><u>Roll Call: Present: J. Lippert, Englerth, A. Fiala</u></b><br/> <b><u>Visitors: 3 (Not including staff present)</u></b><br/> <b><u>Acknowledgement of Visitors:</u></b><br/> <b><u>Ms. Jaimee Conroy, Environmental Scientist Western MI Regional Manager – PLM Lake &amp; Land Management Corp.</u></b> Ms. Conroy noted that she manages Payne Lake Weed Control/Treatment and the main goal is to control exotic plants to the maximum possible. Ms. Conroy noted that what has changed is the Starry Stonewort which is another invasive species growing along the lake bottom along with Eurasian Milfoil. Ms. Conroy commented that she is asking just to continue or “extend” the Weed Control program for Payne Lake.<br/> <b>Ron Blouw, Payne Lake Association President</b>, commented that at the recent association meeting the vote was unanimous to continue the weed control program.<br/> Supervisor Englerth spoke of impediment where Payne Creek goes underneath (M-179). Englerth has been getting calls on the lake level of Payne Lake. Englerth spoke of the Drain Commissioner not being opposed to making a drain district.<br/> J. Lippert inquired regarding phragmites. Ms. Conroy noted the difficulty in getting rid of phragmites. Cutting and burning were mentioned. J. Lippert also mentioned the Purple Loosestrife. Conroy noted that this invasive weed grows along the shoreline and at this point they (PLM) are not permitted to go up the inlet or down the outlet channel (of Payne Lake).
