NEW BUSINESS:

- **CSPR 26-08-04; Parcel ID: 16-019-017-10**, 12515 W. M-179 Highway, Wayland MI. The applicant, Ryan Winchel, is requesting a business site plan review for a proposed outbuilding on this property pursuant to the Yankee Springs Township Ordinance, Article V Site Plan Review.

Ryan Winchel spoke and said he is asking to put an outbuilding for storage on the SW corner of the Gun Lake Putt Putt Golf business that he owns on M179.

Joe Shea, Zoning Administrator, noted that the problem is the Chief Noonday Overlay setback requirement.

The Planning Commission can table this tonight and recommend Ryan Winchel go to the Zoning Board of Appeals to seek a variance of the setback requirement.

Public Hearing opened at 7:19 pm.

Dave Laansma said he appreciates the owner and this business opening up, and hopes that we can find a way to make this happen.

Public Hearing closed at 7:22 pm.

Jim McManus provided a document on a Data Center Ordinance. He suggested adding a Moratorium Section to our Ordinance with a 12 month moratorium with allowance for extension.

The Data Center Ordinance will be reviewed by the Planning Commission and discussed again next month.

Motion by Fiala with support from Frigmanski to recommend that the Township Board of Trustees approve a 12 month Moratorium on Data Centers.

Motion by Trygier with support from Smith to opt out of Section 108 paragraph 6 (PA 58 of 2025) in the Land Division document presented.

Motion by Trygier with support from Craven to schedule a Public Hearing on the change to Land Division Amendment Section 14, which adds: "1. New lots or parcels created, and existing lots or parcels combined shall conform to this Ordinance and the requirements of the Land Division Act, being Act 288 of the Public Acts of 1976, as amended. Yankee Springs Township elects to opt out of Section 108 (6) of PA 58 of 2025 and shall not authorize land divisions beyond those otherwise permitted by the Land Division Act."
