STORMWATER DRAINAGE REVIEW

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish a practice of Barry County Drain Commissioner review of new development and redevelopment projects in Yankee Springs Township so as to minimize adverse impacts of storm water runoff on the Kalamazoo River/Lake Allegan watershed.

2. BACKGROUND

The Gun Lake Area Sewer & Water Authority, as a condition of its discharge permit, is required to be a member of the Kalamazoo River/Lake Allegan Watershed Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) cooperative agreement. The goal of the TMDL is to reduce phosphorus that makes its way into the Kalamazoo River and, eventually, the Great Lakes through storm water runoff. One of the requirements from the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) is that each member establish practices to ensure that all plans for development and redevelopment of properties meet runoff standards. The County Drain Commissioner currently reviews most development and redevelopment projects for storm water runoff.

3. REQUIREMENT FOR THE REVIEW OF DEVELOPMENT AND REDEVELOPMENT PLANS

All plans for development and redevelopment projects submitted to the Zoning Administrator or such other Township personnel charged with building code and/or zoning ordinance compliance within the limits of Yankee Springs Township shall be referred for review to, and placed under the authority of, the Barry County Drain Commissioner.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This policy shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Trustees.

At the Re-scheduled Meeting of March 15th, 2016, Yankee Springs Township Board of Trustees Hereby adopted Resolution No. 03-01-2016 Storm water Drainage Review New Development and redevelopment projects in Yankee Springs Township – by Barry County Drain Commissioner.
